### Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **16** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **144** Health facilities.

#### **Public Health Action Taken**

- Government has started psychiatric/ mental counselling facility from 104 Helpline service. The citizens who are in need may call at toll-free helpline 104.
- Government has introduced a new initiative for tele-medicine service through **e-Sanjeevani OPD** (online Portal for tele-consultation).
- To combat the COVID-19 pandemic situation, the state government has notified revised discharge policy for cured and treated COVID-19 patients as per the directions of GOI.

### APPEAL

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeal to citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who are contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from outside the state must observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house.

#### **NOTE:**

- After release of the Health update yesterday at 8.00 PM, Twenty Three (23) more COVID-19 positive cases were reported on 02.06.2020 at 11:45 PM. The description of positive detected patients is as below:

- Today 01 COVID-19 Positive patient died in Max Hospital, Dehradun. As per Death summary provided by the hospital **the cause of death is Refractory Shock with Severe Metabolic Acidosis with Severe Aortic Stenosis with moderate Aortic Regurgitation.**
- Today 07 COVID-19 patients are recovered and discharged from different districts (05 from Tehri, 01 from Nainital and 01 from U.S.Nagar).
- 01 Female, Age 23 year died in Quarantine facility of Thailisain block, district Pauri. As per communication from CMO Pauri the female was brought to quarantine facility on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020, she developed fever & cold on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020, given treatment & expired yesterday night. Sample for COVID-19 will be sent to lab for testing.
