- Doubling rate for COVID19 Positive Cases in Uttarakhand **29 days** (02ndMay-25th April 2020)





Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts.

Public Health Action Taken

- One More Testing Lab for COVID-19 was started at Shri. Veer Chandra Singh Garhwali Government Medical College, Srinagar (Pauri Garhwal). This is the fourth public sector testing lab for COVID-19 in Uttarakhand.
- Government has introduced a new initiative for tele-medicine service through eSanjeevani OPD (online Portal for tele-consultation).

Note

A resident of Dehradun went for treatment in Apollo Hospital, New Delhi on dated 28th April 2020, he was there till 30th April 2020. Hospital authorities tested him for COVID-19 and he tested Positive on dated 30th April 2020. He was discharged by Apollo Hospital, New Delhi without due COVID-19 protocol. Now the patient has returned home to Dehradun and IDSP unit Dehradun has admitted the patient in AIIMS Rishikesh on 02nd May 2020.

APPEAL

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who have been advised quarantine (Contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from outside the state) have to observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house.

Preventive measures

1. All citizens must wear masks whenever venturing outside of their homes.
2. Facility quarantine of all asymptomatic travelers for next 28 days after returning from outside Uttarakhand.
3. Travelers' and their family members must ensure strict respiratory and hand hygiene.
4. Cover your face while coughing or sneezing, wash hands frequently and avoid handshakes.
